# Travel Clinic

At Manor Park Medical Centre we have qualified clinical staff available to discuss your travel requirements and they will recommend what NHS vaccinations are appropriate for your journey overseas.

If the website recommends vaccinations other than those available on the NHS, you will need to attend a Travel Clinic for those to be administered.

Our nursing staff will not be able to discuss any other recommendations for the country you are visiting other than those listed by the NHS overleaf, therefore it is important you access the website and make your own informed choice from there.

- Call in to Reception and collect a travel questionnaire at least 6 weeks before your travel date. Alternatively please print one from our website: [www.manorparksurgery.co.uk](http://www.manorparksurgery.co.uk).
- Complete the questionnaire with the details of your journey and return it to the Reception staff, they will then book you a 20 minute appointment with a Nurse who will discuss your questionnaire and start your NHS vaccination program if appropriate.
- No appointment will be booked without the completed questionnaire.

## NHS Free Travel Vaccinations

Hepatitis A (infections hepatitis)	1st and 2nd/booster
Combined Hepatitis A and B	All doses
Combined Hepatitis A and Typhoid	First dose (2nd is with Hep A alone)
Typhoid	1st and any booster doses
Tetanus, Diphtheria and Polio	Given in the combined Td/IPV
